Accounting and Finance

- A four-year programme leading to the **BA (Hons) Degree in Accounting Finance**.
- A two-year programme leading to the **M.Sc degree in Financial Management**.
- A four-year programme leading to the **Diploma of the Association of International Accountants (AIA) of the U.K. and/or the Institute of Certified Public Accountants in Ireland (CPA)**.

ADMISSION & OTHER REQUIREMENTS:

International Students

- Completed application form
- Official transcript of secondary school grades and other higher qualifications and where applicable an approved English Language qualification
- Character reference from police (original)
- Photocopies of front page of passport
- Banker's guarantee of US\$10,000 per year
- A minimum deposit of US\$2,000 is required before the immigration process can commence. A proportion of the deposit is refundable should the student be unable to enter the country; otherwise it is applied towards tuition upon enrolment.

Programme of Study

- **ACCOUNTING & FINANCE** (2 years, Diploma)
 - A two-year programme leading to the **Diploma in Accounting and Finance**.
- **FINANCIAL MARKETS & SECURITIES ANALYSIS** (2 years, Diploma)
 - A two-year programme leading to the **Diploma in Financial Markets & Securities Analysis**.



- **ACCOUNTING & FINANCE** (4 years, B.A.)
 - A four-year programme leading to the **BA (Hons) Degree in Accounting and Finance**.
 - Holders of the BA (Hons) Degree in Accounting and Finance are granted exemption from:
 - a) Foundation & Professional 1 exams of the Association of the International Accountants (AIA) of the UK and
 - b) Formation 1 & 2 and Professional 1 exams of the Institute of Certified Public Accountants in Ireland.

The AIA is one of the five bodies recognised under Part II of the Companies Act 1989 as a Recognised Qualifying Body (RQB). This statutory recognition of the **AIA qualification is equivalent** to that granted to the other RQB's namely, the Institute of **Chartered Accountants** in England and Wales, the Institute and Chartered Accountants in Scotland, the Institute of Chartered Accountants in Ireland and the Association of **Certified Accountants**.
- **FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT** (2 years, M.Sc)
 - A two-year programme leading to the **Master of Science in**:
 - **Financial Management in the Public Sector**
 - **Business Finance**

plus 2 or 3 electives from:

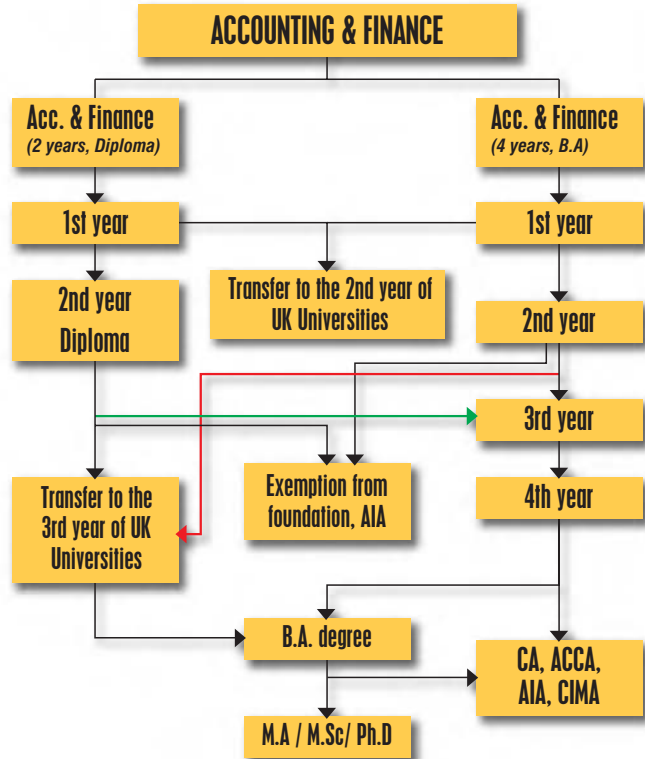
