- Certificate in Law* - an accredited one-year full-time course of study.
- Bachelor of Law (LLB, Hons) - a four-year full-time course of study.
- Master of Law (LLM) - a distance learning course of 15 months duration.

ADMISSION & OTHER REQUIREMENTS:

International Students

- Completed application form
- Official transcript of secondary school grades and other higher qualifications and where applicable an approved English Language qualification
- Character reference from police (original)
- Photocopies of front page of passport
- Banker's guarantee of US\$10,000 per year
- A minimum deposit of US\$2,000 is required before the immigration process can commence. A proportion of the deposit is refundable should the student be unable to enter the country; otherwise it is applied towards tuition upon enrolment.

Plus 1 or 2 from:

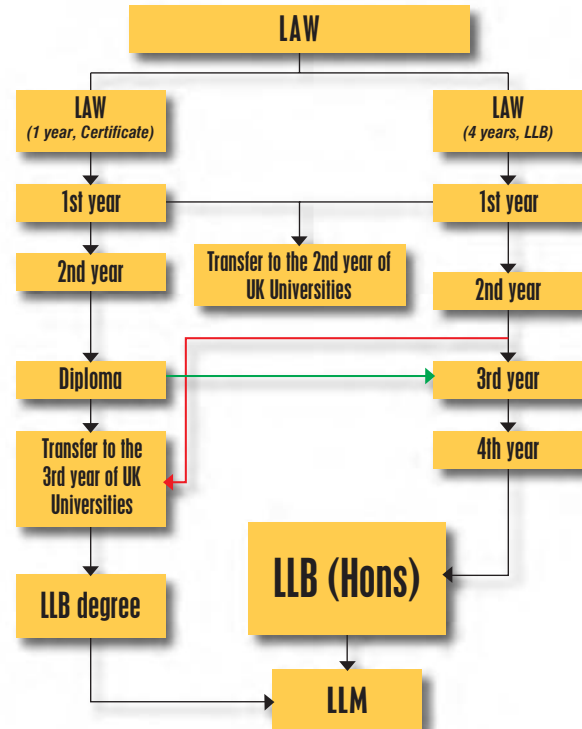
Multimedia and Internet Technology, General Psychology, Communication and Language Development, Introduction to Sociology.
